The ancient Indian and Greek systems of education emphasised morality/ character as the ultimate goal of education. The culture, social efficiency and discipline are moral traits. Moral virtues like truthfulness, sincerity, honesty and justice promote the social efficiency of the individual.

The importance of moral aim of education is that it helps man to raise to a high level, developing noble, moral and humanistic qualities promote the social efficiency of the individual. Morality is the greatest unifying force in life of the individual.

Individual aim of education means that education should develop individuals according to their interests, capacities and specialities. The narrow meaning of individual aim means self-expression, all round development of child's powers and natural development of child. Full freedom should be given to the child, to develop according to his instincts.

The wider meaning of individual aim of education is 'self-realization'. The child should be given all those opportunities which may help in the total development of all his powers and in making him an excellent individual and capable person.

Modern psychology places a lot of emphasis on individual differences. All individuals differ from one another in respect of their interests, abilities, attitudes and personality. So education should be individual oriented.
